


SELECTMEN'S POLICY
YELLOW RIBBONS
August 23, 2011

As discussed at the Selectmen's meeting of August 23, 2011, the Board of Selectmen, Town of Alfred agree to establish the "YELLOW RIBBON" policy to read as follows:

In order to express honor to those serving in the armed forces of the United States, the nine trees on the Alfred Village Green are the designated sites on Town-owned property, upon which yellow ribbons may be placed. There shall be one ribbon per each tree, for a total of nine.

Yellow ribbons will be replaced every three months or sooner if needed. Any ribbon(s) deemed disrespectful (dirty, tattered, faded, etc.) will be taken down by a designee of the Board of Selectmen.


This policy will be in effect as of August 23, 2011 and will be reviewed annually.
