

Selectmen's Meeting
September 7, 2016
Wednesday, 8:15 a.m.

The meeting opened at 8:15 a.m. Present were Selectmen George Donovan and Glenn Dochtermann. Tony Palminteri was out of Town. Also present was Joyce Wood, Administrative Assistant.

The Board requested that the Code Officer, Jim Allaire, speak with them about the Drug Detox Center. He then reported that he has received an application for the center and that it will have to go before the Planning Board with notification to all abutters. A date for this has not yet been set.

Glenn Dochtermann reported that F.R. Carroll is working on shouldering of the Gebung Road this morning.

George Donovan reported that he has spoken with the owner of Flag Waivers where the village flags were purchased. The Owner said that, after looking at the torn flags, the torn material seemed faulty to him. But he then added that typically the flags last one season and then begin to fade and deteriorate. The Board discussed how long and the timeframe for leaving the flags out. After further discussion, all were in agreement to invite Chris Carpenter, Full Time Firefighter, in to meet with the Board to discuss this further. Also discussed was the suggestion made to contact Senator Collins about requesting a larger flag that was flown at the Capital to use on the large pole on the Town Green as these are usually given upon request for free.

The Board then discussed the request from the York County Shelter to use the Town owned tents and some tables and chairs for their annual Apple Festival to be held on September 24th and 25th. It was noted that Mr. Palminteri has given his approval via e-mail. It was moved by Glenn Dochtermann and seconded by George Donovan to authorize the request. All voted in favor.

The minutes of the August 30, 2016 Selectmen's meeting were read. Motion was made by Mr. Dochtermann followed by second from Mr. Donovan to accept them as written. All voted in favor.

After review of the warrants, Glenn Dochtermann made a motion to approve and sign them as submitted. George Donovan seconded, all voted in favor and the warrants were signed.

Income to the Festival account, the Fueling February account and the Employee Benefit account and to the Town Insurance account was accepted and appropriated by the Board as submitted. It was noted that the income from Workers Compensation was a reimbursement due to the Town's minor use of this insurance. The reimbursement amount was \$2,315.00.
